Greetings Gardening Friends,

I hope you enjoyed the presentation last month on Indiana ferns. There are quite a few different types growing in Indiana. During the business meeting, the proposed budget was passed.

This month (Tuesday, April 5) our own Chuck Bunnell is presenting on "The Ups And Downs Of Hybridizing". Chuck is a retired PhD chemist from Eli Lilly who began growing iris fifteen years prior to his retirement and quickly found he could fill many hours with this hobby. He not only grows iris but has been hybridizing iris for the past 32 years. Chuck has introduced 14 iris in the Miniature Tall Bearded classification. His introduction, "Dividing Line", introduced in 2005, was the first MTB awarded the top honor in the American Iris Society, winning the Dykes Medal in 2014. His garden holds over 1000 named iris varieties along with his seedling beds which house up to another 1000 iris he is evaluating. He will share the challenges of developing new iris varieties.

We had another good time at the Flower & Patio Show. Many folks stopped by to visit and talk about flowers. Thanks to those of you who potted up plants last fall, we had over 40 varieties of flowers to sell with almost 80 pots. All the plants were sold and earned over \$500 for the club. A big thanks to all of you who volunteered to staff the booth!

The Hendricks County Master Gardener show will be coming up this month on Saturday, April 23, 9am-4pm in Danville, IN. If you would like to volunteer at this show, please let me know. If any of you have potted plants that could be sold, please bring them to our April meeting. Our supply of potted plants is quite low now because of the success of the Flower & Patio Show.
