### **President's message**

Greetings Gardening Friends,

What a great time we had promoting daylilies and iris at the Indiana Flower & Patio Show this year. Hundreds of visitors stopped by and chatted about flowers. We gained several new members. Many planting guides and IDIS event flyers were distributed. Many thanks to those of you who potted up plants last fall! Over 200 potted daylily/iris plants were sold, many in a buzz of activity on the opening weekend. Special thanks to all who volunteered to staff the booth!

Our next gardening event will be the Hendricks County Master Gardener show on Saturday, April 27, 9am-4pm in Danville, IN. Mary Vinson will be coordinating our booth that day. Might you be able to volunteer that day for an 8-12 shift or 12-4pm shift? If any of you have potted plants that could be sold, please bring them to our April meeting. Our supply of potted plants is quite low now because of the success of the Flower & Patio Show.

Our speaker this month (April 2) will be David Toth from Indian Creek Iris, Pickrell, NE who will present "The Present and Future of Novelty Iris". David became interested in iris in 1983 after attending an iris show in southern California hosted by the San Fernando Iris Society. He became a youth member that day and went home with a bag full of iris. Over the next twenty years he was in and out of iris as he moved around. farm in SE Nebraska and began serious hybridizing of iris, deciding in 2007 to focus only on the novelty class of iris, clearing out all of the other iris from his garden. After spending many years building genetic lines, he introduced his first iris in 2017. Since that time he has introduced about 150 new iris varieties. Both of his daughters, Ava (18) and Evelyn (13), have also joined him in hybridizing and have made a name for themselves with their own introductions. Novelty iris can include things like variegated foliage, purple stems, flat forms, broken colors, extra petals, horns/spoons/flounces at the end of the beard, etc. Come and hear about current variations available in iris, as well as future directions in the Novelty class.

At our March meeting we did approve the proposed budget for 2024. This year we will be getting our NCAP daylilies from Ginny Pearce, Grand Rapids, MI, and Bart Beck, Murtaugh, ID. Our NCAP iris will be from David Toth, Pickrell, NE.

Laurel Richardson, Alex Sutherland, and Mary Vinson have agreed to serve on the Nominating Committee. Is there some position you might be willing to fill? Is there someone you might recommend or encourage? Would you have an interest in shadowing a current board member to see what a position might involve?

As you are working in the garden this spring and have extra plants, bring them along to the April meeting to share with others in the free exchange.
