Thanks to Tom Bohn and Mary Vinson for already representing our club this year at the January Master Gardener Spring Garden Clinic held at St Luke's United Methodist Church.

Mary has been working to line up our 2023 speakers and our March meeting will feature a presentation from the Hamilton County Master Gardeners entitled "Attracting Pollinators". Our meetings will be held in the First Friends Church fellowship hall where masks are now optional.

We will again have a free educational booth at the Indiana Flower & Patio Show, March 11-19. The show opens each day at 10am and usually closes at 7 or 8pm. Might you have four hours of time to volunteer at the booth? You get free admission and can visit the many other booths when you're not working. There will be a sign up sheet at our March meeting. If you have extra plastic bags we can use to for our customer's plants, please bring them along to the March meeting.

There will be some changes in our schedule/events this year. **1.** Our May meeting will be the second Tuesday because of the primary election on the first Tuesday. **2.** Greg will be buying the NCAP daylilies from Daylily World (Kirchhoff/Morss) and Thoroughbred Daylilies (John/Annette Rice). The main agenda at the March meeting will be the review and approval of the 2023 budget which is attached. A second agenda item to consider is the board recommendation that the Iris and Daylily Shows be on an alternating schedule rather than having both shows each year. It is suggested that we hold a Daylily Show this year and then an Iris Show next year with the pattern to continue thereafter. What are your thoughts on that? A third item of business will be consideration of hosting the AIS Region 6 Spring meeting in May, 2025. This would be a one day event that is revenue neutral. There could be guest plants as well as open gardens to visit. Participants would find their own lodging if they decided to come down earlier. Is this something the club would be willing to host? Might you be interested in helping host/plan such an event?

Be sure to also look over the 2023 calendar of events as it includes both regional and national meetings which you may want to attend.
