What a busy summer we've had. John Everitt, Dan Howell, and Tom Bohn spent a number of hours digging, dividing, and then planting Jim Poor's daylilies. They will be coming to our annual August sale next year. About ten folks later returned to the Poor residence and dug, divided, and labeled Jim's iris which were sold at this year's sale. There were forecasts for rain on the day of the dig but fortunately most of the rain held off until the afternoon. We had a good sale although there seemed to be less foot traffic this year. Most of the donated daylilies were sold as well as many of the iris. Laurel purchased all the remaining plants to take to the southern Indiana flower clubs. The sale raised a bit more than \$2900 for the club.
